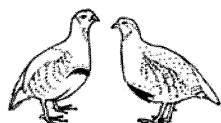


21 Lynwood, High Street

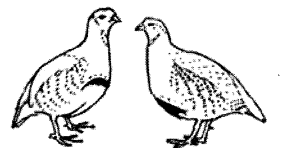
